

Privacy Policy

The privacy and security of your personal information is important to us. This policy explains how and why we use your personal data, to make sure you stay informed and can be confident about giving us your information.

This policy applies if you are a supporter of the Maun Conservation Group (member, donor, volunteer) and use electronic means of contacting us, call or write to us.

We will never sell, trade or rent your details to third parties.

Your personal data (any information which identifies you, or which can be identified as relating to you personally for example, name, address, phone number, email address) may be collected and used by us.

You can give us your personal data by filling in forms, donations or by corresponding with us (including by phone, social media, email or by joining as a member/supporter).

The personal data you give us may include, but is not limited to your name, title, address, email address, telephone number and photographs. Your activities and involvement with us may result in personal data being created. This could include details of how you have helped us by volunteering or being involved with our campaigns and activities. If you decide to donate to us, then we will keep records of when and how much you give.

We will only use your personal data on relevant lawful grounds as permitted by the EU General Protection Regulation from 25 May 2018 UK Data Protection Act and Privacy of Electronic Communication Regulation.

We may use your details to contact you for various reasons associated with the group that may include informing you of the latest events or volunteering activities where we need your support, to send you notice of our meetings and our Maun Conservation Group minutes.
