

The Maun Conservation Group is a volunteer organisation, encouraging everyone to be involved with nature and Maun's stunning environment. We work with surrounding primary schools, as having children involved with nature at an early age is something we view as most important. We liaise with local authority groups and national charities, including: Mansfield District Council; the Environment Agency; Parks Development Officers; Waterside Care; Keep Britain Tidy; Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust; and, the NCC Biodiversity Action Group. These links have enabled us to obtain support and guidance on delivering projects.

The Group look after two connected sites: Quarry Lane Nature Reserve which runs along the banks of the River Maun, and next to Quarry Lane. It extends up to Sheepbridge Lane and to the Nottingham Road. Oakham Nature Reserve is bounded by Bleakhills Lane, Hamilton Way and Sheepbridge Lane. The Reserve features woodland walks and a spectacular wild flower meadow in summer.

We need new volunteers! All of our members generously donate their time to help look after the local area. We have volunteering opportunities, which include: teaching school and youth groups; conservation work; sub-groups that look after birds, fish, amphibians, trees, wild flowers and a programme to promote all of these areas.
